What is the ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform?

The Enacted Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform is a virtual community that aims to promote collaboration and connectivity among primary & secondary school teachers, civil society organizations and policy makers, with the aim to provide quality and inclusive education for migrant students' integration.

In Europe, the percentage of students with a migrant background is rapidly increasing, even though students with an immigrant background continue to have poorer performance outcomes in schools than students without an immigrant background, thus often facing difficulties in adjusting to a new learning environment.

If you work in the field of **formal or non-formal education** and you are eager to learn how to keep up with the learning needs of newly arrived migrant students (**NAMS**) this platform will enlighten you about innovative practices to apply in diverse and multilingual classrooms.

Indeed, the ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform was started with the aim of **supporting educators in responding to the different needs of NAMS to strengthen their integration into the educational and social system of the receiving country.**

How does it work?

The ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform is a networking platform where you can take part in **vibrant roundtables**, together with other formal and non-formal educators and stakeholders, to discuss about innovative practices in the field of inclusive education with a

problem-solving approach. You will have the chance to learn from other successful education practices while sharing your personal experiences about NAMS integration.

What can you find in the platform?

Taking an active role in the ENACTED Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform will give you the big advantage of accessing a **catalogue of innovative practices** in the field of inclusive education contained in 'Depository of Innovative Practices for Inclusive Education' (DIPIE). According to your needs regarding the implementation level (local, regional, national, European) or the target groups (primary or secondary schools), you can preselect and identify the practices you are interested in, read brief summaries, and enroll for free **downloading**.

Furthermore, depending on your interest you can take part in different thematic working groups (Enhancing teachers' training on intercultural education, increasing parental involvement, Inclusive education of NAMS/Preventing school segregation, etc.) to discuss with other educators how to adequately address the educational barriers faced by newly arrived migrants in Europe.

Each working group has the chance to participate to the drafting of the ENACTED 'Charter of Common Values for Education and Diversity' that will contribute to inclusive education, non-discrimination and equal opportunity for all in Europe.
