The European Network of Active Civil society for Education and Diversity considers teachers as probably the most important stakeholders with an inherent deep understanding of the unique challenges posed by policies and society. What happened until now?

The ENACTED partners participated in an online monitoring meeting on the 7th of May where partners were presented with the collections of practices with the total amount reaching 101: 31 for Greece, 20 for Italy, 25 for Cyprus and 25 for Spain.

More than 50 % are addressed to NAMS, then to Teachers and as 3rd group we have parents. In analyzing the practice one by one project partner Stimmuli will come back to each partner for asking further or deeper information/documentation in order to respect the country policy profiles to have more equal representation in the DIPIE. Then Stimmuli will share a strategy for the evaluation and selection methodology for the 50 practices.





What is coming up next?

Development of the Inclusive Education Acceleration Online Platform (DIPIE). This is the most critical and innovative component of the ENACTED as all major functions regarding the project's innovative networking activities will take place through that Online Platform.
